Late Entries: Entries received after 6:00pm EST on June 29, 2024, will be charged a Day of Entry (DOE) fee of \$35.00 per entry, per dog, per test.

We anticipate full capacity and will only issue refunds for bitches in season and dogs determined unfit to complete at inspection at the event. There are no refunds for absent dogs.

These will be **concurrent** tests using a **block schedule**. NO RUN ORDER will be mailed out. A time block will be assigned. An email explaining the process will be sent out prior to the event.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are registered with the AKC, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program on the day of the event. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

Dogs may only run once per test.

Hours:

Grounds will be available one hour prior to event hours. Start time is 9:00am Event hours are from 9:00am until all runs are completed.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready with catcher and releaser when their dog is called to the line.

Prizes:

Penobscot Valley Kennel Club will offer a flat light blue ribbon for a passing qualifying run. I Penobscot Valley Kennel Club will also offer Rosettes for new titles – please alert the Secretary if you expect to complete a title at this event. Rosettes are 12" BCAT, 15" DCAT, 18" FCAT

Roll Call:

Events will run concurrently with rolling check-in and inspection.

Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your scheduled block.

This is a "show & go" event, we ask that you depart the site when you have completed all your runs unless you are available to assist other entrants.

Every dog must pass through inspection before each run. Dogs who have not been inspected for each run will not be run. If you do not check in within one hour prior to the end of the test closing, we will assume you are absent.

No refunds for absent dogs. At inspection, all dogs will be examined for fitness to run. Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. Please contact the Test Secretary if your bitch comes in season prior to the event. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs only will be excused with entry refunded.

Early acceptance of dogs for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published test hours.

What is Fast CAT?

- 1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
- 2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is not completely fenced, and dogs are run individually.
- 3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH). MPH is calculated by:

204.545 divided by the run time (204.545/X=MPH)

- 4. Based on the dog's size at the withers a handicap is applied, and points are earned:
 - 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5
 - Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0

5. Formula: MPH X Handicap = Points

Titles are earned at specific point levels.
 BCAT = 150 points, DCAT = 500 points, FCAT = 1,000 points
 FCAT # = Each additional 500 points

******According to AKC Rules: Handlers are not permitted to run with a dog during an official run but must remain either at the start or finish area of the course. Handlers are not to allow dogs to be enticed through the course with anything other than the lure during tis official run. NO mechanical devices including whistles, horns, bull horns, etc. or food or toys including the waving of objects to lure the dog to the finish line. You MAY CHEER and use the dog's name only.

Test Site Directions:

From South:

I-95 to Clinton then exit 138 towards Clinton. Turn right onto Hinkley Road, 1.1 miles turn left onto Main Street/ ME 100, 0.1 miles. Left onto Railroad St., 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Mutton Lane, 5.0 miles. Turn right onto Johnson Float Road. Event is 0.2 miles on right.

From North:

I-95 to Clinton then exit 138 towards Clinton. Turn left onto Hinkleyh Road. 1.1 miles turn left onto Main Street/ ME 100, 0.1 miles. Left onto Railroad St., 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Mutton Lane, 5.0 miles. Turn right onto Johnson Float Road. Event is 0.2 miles on right.

Please bring water and snacks for you and your dogs. There is no food available on-site. There will be portable toilets on-site.

Test Information

- All entries must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNERS' SOLE RISK
- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- The event grounds may not be completely fenced. The Fast CAT course is fully fenced.
- An electric and electronic timing system will be used.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- On-site bathroom facilities are available.
- The Hunt Master is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. He/She has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs (determined unfit at inspection) will be excused and their entry fees will be refunded. NO REFUNDS FOR ABSENT DOGS.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC/sponsoring Club(s)/dog(s) or person(s) will be asked to leave the event site by the Field Committee, may be disciplined by the AKC, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if: the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- Penobscot Valley Kennel Club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
